Pre-Operation Inspection

When?: A pre-operational inspection must be carried out before using the loading equipment in any activity in the yard.

Why?: It is important to know if the loading equipment to be used is in optimal condition for operation and that during its use we don't have any incident derived from the physical condition of the loading equipment.

How?: On the windshield of the loading equipment we will be using, there is a QR code with the inspection check list.
